HISTORY

That 70's Thing came on to the Houston music scene in 2014, when veteran musicians Todd Fulks and Joe Cavazos formed the band to provide an upbeat, dance and party experience to nightclubs and corporate events - quickly earning a reputation as the party band of choice. The band line up brings Niki Dillon as lead vocalist, Charlie Lair on guitars, Steve Vonderheide on keyboards, Karen Dorman as backing vocalist, Todd Fulks as percussionist, and Joe Cavazos on bass. Each band member has over 25 years of seasoned music performance background ranging from recording to touring acts. This 6-piece band has performed not only in nightclubs, but also at corporate functions, private parties, city festivals, and benefit events. In 2017, That 70's Thing organized a multiband benefit concert and raised thousands of dollars - all donated to the JJ Watt foundation to assist in Hurricane Harvey relief efforts. The band has been cited in the local media multiple times, is firmly established as the party band in the Houston area, and is available for booking for local, state, and out-of-state events.

That 70's Thing's principal genres are dance, funk, disco, and rock... Think the energy of New York's "Studio-54". In addition, for corporate events and weddings, the band can adjust their repertoire - augmenting to harmonize with dinner or cocktail hours.
